



## Yulgilbar Schools - Training Days & Ranch Experiences

Since its inception, Yulgilbar has aspired to foster great horsemen and women and the highest standards of horsemanship. Since the 1980's Yulgilbar has held schools at Elgee Park on the Mornington Peninsula with Australian and Overseas instructors recognised for their outstanding achievements in their equestrian and western disciplines.

In the past few years Yulgilbar has increased its commitment by holding schools and training days not only at Elgee Park but also at its property Argyle at Tamworth as well as the birthplace of the Yulgilbar Quarter Horse Stud, Yulgilbar Station near Grafton, NSW.

Yulgilbar provides a range of activities and experiences for all levels of riders at its three locations.

**Schools or Clinics** are generally held at Elgee Park over two days where the participant receives instruction or coaching from a professional horseman or woman. Each participant will receive individual and group attention along with plenty of social time.

**Training Days** are held as a one day activity at Elgee Park and Argyle. Participant are provided with cattle and/or the Yulgilbar facilities to use for a practice or training session. In some cases, instruction is also provided for participants. Cutting preworks are also included in this category.

**Ranch Experiences and / or Ranch Cuttings** are generally an invitational event where participants are involved in a number of activities such as mustering, paddock cutting and trail riding. There is accommodation, meals and entertainment provided in the package along with instruction on request. These are held at Yulgilbar Station.

- Participants can book into more than 1 session over the 2-day clinic.
- Participants can book out an entire session of private coaching or name the 5 participants in the session; ideal for clubs and schools.
- Participants can specify what areas of cutting they like to concentrate; show craft, training, horsemanship or specific problems.
- A limited number of fence sitting positions will be available each day for non- riders. **\$70+GST per day paid prior to September 30.**
